Dear Parents/Guardians

School updates 2023/04 (Secondary 3 Normal (A))

1. Homework and Revision

It is imperative that students cultivate the habit of completing their homework on time in order to reinforce their learning in class and succeed in their studies. It is through homework that teachers are able to identify their students' learning gaps and address them as soon as possible. Please continue to work with us to cultivate in your child the habit of completing homework on time and revising his/her work regularly as he/she prepares for his assessments in Term 2.

2. Academic Consultation with Teachers

Students are encouraged to clarify their doubts with their subject teachers during lessons. In the event that they remain unclear after the lesson, they could arrange to meet with their teachers after school for consultation. Clarifications should be sought early so that misconceptions do not adversely affect learning in the future.

3. Experience ITE Programme (EIP)

As part of the school's efforts to help students make informed decisions about higher institutes of learning, your child/ward will be attending the Experience ITE Programme (EIP). The EIP is specially designed for secondary school students to experience ITE's **Hands-On, Minds-On, Hearts-On**TM education and be immersed in ITE's authentic learning environments. Through the EIP, students are given opportunities to try out a range of fun and practical projects, which could help instil interest in skills education and provide important Education and Career Guidance (ECG).

Students will report to school as usual and two-way transport will be provided.

4. Secondary 3 Parent-Teacher Meeting

The Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) will take place on **Friday, 26 May 2023**. It will be held on a virtual platform via Zoom. To facilitate the meeting with as many parents/guardians as possible, the PTM will be held from **8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.** Hence, there will be no physical lessons conducted that day. It will be a home-based learning day as per some past Fridays. **We strongly encourage both parents/guardian to attend the PTM with your child/ward**, to ensure common understanding of your child's/ ward's progress and follow-up actions, moving forward.

You will receive a message from Parents Gateway app to book a 20-minute timeslot to meet your child's/ ward's Home Tutor. The booking will start from 11 to 18 May 2023. More information for the booking will be provided later. We seek your cooperation to adhere to the timeslot you have booked.

Your child/ward will receive his/her Semestral 1 report on 25 May 2023.

In the event you are unable to attend the PTM on 26 May, please contact your child's/ward's Home Tutor to arrange for a separate Zoom meeting during the first week of June, especially if your child's/ward's learning attitude and

performance has not been satisfactory. We believe the timely sharing of information will help you in guiding your child/ward well in their revision during the June holidays.

5. Secondary 3 Experiential Learning Programme

From **22 to 24 May 2023**, the school will conduct our Experiential Learning Programme (ELP) for all Secondary Three students. The objective of this programme is to allow for learning in a differentiated and extended context beyond the physical space of the classroom.

Students will participate in different learning activities and visit different places outside school on two of the three days. The attire for students during ELP days will be PE T-shirt with skirt/pants. Students will report to school as per normal, by 7.20 a.m. for the flag raising ceremony. All ELP programmes will end at 1.50 p.m..
