Note:

- Students are to report for morning assembly as per normal.
- The venue for Access Arrangement is Computer Lab 1.
- Those who do not have the FIRST PAPER of the day (8am) will report 30 minutes before the start of the NEXT paper. Students are allowed to leave school after their last paper for the day.
- If there is a break between 2 papers, students are to remain in school for self-study.
- All students are expect to report to their respective examination venue 15 minutes before the start of the paper.
- If the student is sick and is unable to sit for the examination for that day, **a medical certificate issued by a doctor** would be required. Otherwise, the student will be considered to have been absent and awarded a zero mark for that particular paper.
- If the student is late for any of the paper, there will not be any extra time given to make up for the loss of time.
